Class Placement and Learning at our School

We use information provided by parents and each student's previous school to place students in home classes with others who are learning at a range of levels. This clustering of students requires teachers to differentiate the learning for individual students within their class. Teachers strive to accelerate the learning of every student, regardless of the academic level with which they enter the school. Children with special abilities are accelerated in home classes and through the Friday Academic High-Performance Classes, while students with additional needs are supported in class and through a range of intervention programmes.

Our school approach is to strengthen each student's emotional resilience and develop their interpersonal skills within a variety of social contexts. All classes are heterogeneous in their structure, enabling students to interact with peers from a variety of backgrounds.
