What is Chrome Education?

Control everything from one simple console with 24/7 support



Lock devices

They can only be used on your domain—even if wiped



Push apps and extensions

To your domain or sets of users



Enforce policies

Google Safe Search and YouTube Restricted Mode keep kids safe



Administer tests at scale

Set up devices remotely with kiosk apps for high-stakes testing

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How do I keep my child safe online?

- Device settings rather than network settings ensure that the Chromebook will act in the same way no matter if the child is at school, home, or a friends house.
- Therefore, safe search settings, various levels of YouTube restrictions and blocked URL's can be applied to the device 100% of the time.



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How do I ensure the device enhances learning and doesn't become a toy?

- By locking down the Chromebook to users of the school domain, schools can disable various apps and extensions that may become a distraction from learning.
- For Chromebooks that can access Android apps through the Google Play store, only school approved apps will be shown.
- Schools can also block various online games that they deem are not enhancing learning in any way.



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What happens if my child loses their Chromebook or it gets stolen?

- Any lost or stolen devices can be disabled.
- A customised message can be applied to the screen.
- The Chromebook cannot be reset, so it will stay locked until the device is returned.



Engaging parents

Community engagement is crucial!

- Parents did not go through school using devices.
- The world is vastly different today.
- It is vitally important that we give our students to opportunities to practice future-focused skills that will allow them to succeed in a rapidly changing future.
- The key message needs to be that when technology is used correctly, it should transform learning.
- Students should have the opportunity to learn anywhere, anytime and at any pace.
- Have an agreement that can be signed by the student, parent and the school that outlines why the school has decided to manage the devices and to outline acceptable use of the Chromebook.
